
1. Color your kite. Hint: Use permanent markers and be sure to make


your pictures big.



2. Tape on dowels.




3. Measure and cut bridle line. It should be six times the width of the kite.







4. Tie each end of the bridle line to the dowels.




5. Tape down bridle line.





6. Fold kite in half so that dowels sit on top of each other.



8. Add tail (optional), tie flying line to the loop in the bridle, and kite is ready to fly!
